## About One Health Operationalisation

This course will introduce participants to the One Health concept as an approach being used to address the existential threat of global pandemics to the health and welfare of people. The course covers trans- and inter-disciplinary fields of both the main drivers of pandemics and the key pillars of resilient health systems in the WHO framework.

Participation in a short online course will be a prerequisite for the travel to Ghana.

## Funding

The German-West-African Centre for Global Health and Pandemic Prevention (G-WAC) is issuing full travel grants for students studying in Germany interested in participating in this course.

## Who can apply?

- Be a Master, PhD or medical student at one of the partner University
- Be Fluent in English
- Ready to travel to Ghana and fully participate

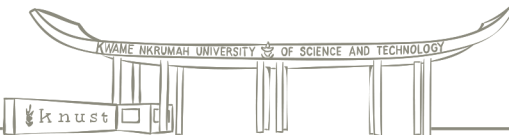
