Abstract submission: July 31st 2023

G-WAC is launching a call for application to all PhD students and researchers affiliated with the Global Health Centres by DAAD (PACE-UP, GLACIER, CAIDERA) to submit an abstract for the second Joint Digital Symposium on Global Health. The symposium will provide an opportunity to present, reflect, discuss, and exchange internationally about Global Health with colleagues around the globe.

The digital symposium will allow PhD students and researchers of the different centres to present ongoing or planned (research) projects (including proposals) or results to a broader/global audience working on similar topics in different contexts, countries and continents. The symposium is an opportunity for networking and collaboration across the Global Health and Pandemic Prevention Centres in emerging and developing countries addressing participants from Africa, Asia, the Near and Middle East, Central & South America, Europe.

Abstract format: For early-stage PhD students, the abstract could focus on the research protocol, results of a systematic literature review, and/or preliminary results. The abstract (max 350 words) should provide a short overview about your research (background, methods, [expected] results, discussion). Please also indicate your level of research and institution/Global Centre.

The Call for application is open. Please send your abstract to (g.wac@international.tu-berlin.de) until August 15th, 2023. Results of the abstract submission will be communicated to you by the end of August.

Thematic focus:

The Digital Symposium will bring together researchers from different disciplines, covering thematic areas including, but not limited to:

- Health systems/ health economics
- Virology/ Diagnostics
- Bacteriology/ Parasitology
- Epidemiology and surveillance
- Community engagement/ Social Sciences
- Digital Health
- Zoonoses

The Digital Symposium will include keynote lectures and parallel sessions on the above-mentioned thematic areas with short input presentations and discussions. It will also provide an opportunity for participants to network and to find areas of common interest.
